## The PhD program at the *Université de Lorraine* (English version)

In France, the PhD program is open to holders of a Master Degree, after they have been admitted to a graduate school (PhD school) in charge of the PhD program. The PhD is obtained after three years of research, following a doctoral thesis on the realization of original scientific research.

The 400 theses currently defended at the Université de Lorraine account for approximately 5% of the PhD degrees delivered in France. 1 800 doctoral students are currently working on their theses in 61 different research laboratories. Close to half of our doctoral students come to us internationally, representing 80 different nationalities, and 11% of the theses are supervised in collaboration with a foreign university.

The Université de Lorraine offers a wide range of PhD degree specialties, from engineering sciences to theology. There are eight PhD schools. The Université de Lorraine's support services to doctoral studies offer supplementary trainings to meet your needs, they also organize the monitoring of the PhD students and work to promote the PhD program. The PhD program of the Université de Lorraine covers a wide range of disciplines:

- Mathematics, Computer science
- Chemistry, Physics
- Mechanics, Electronics, Engineering sciences
- Life sciences, Health, Earth, Universe
- Legal, political and economic sciences, Management
- Foreign languages, Literature and Civilization, Arts
- Humanities and social studies, Geography, History, Language Sciences, Applied Linguistics

Prior to starting a PhD abroad, you must find a host laboratory, a thesis supervisor with whom you will work to determine a thesis topic and to clear funding modalities for the three years of your thesis. ### Doctoral training

The PhD is above all a training for research, through research. Most of the training time is devoted to the research task within the laboratory. According to the regulation of each PhD School, the doctoral students can be asked to follow complementary scientific training modules within the period of their thesis.

The PhD schools also arrange cross-functional trainings that give doctoral students complementary skills.

## The PhD Program at the *Université de Lorraine* (explained in Chinese - Mandarin)

洛林大学 (UL)

，新命名于2012年1月1日，主校园位于法国东北部洛林大区(Lorraine)的南锡市(Nancy)和梅兹市(Metz)，

是法国著名的公立综合性大学之一。洛林大区与德国、比利时和卢森堡交界，是法国通向西欧诸国重要的交通枢纽，与巴黎也相当接近，乘高速火车(TGV)1

个半小时可到达。洛林大学的前身是3所同类型的公立综合性大学和1所专业性较强的工程师学校合并而来，他们分别是洛林大学-南锡一大 (Université Henri Poincaré/Université Nancy 1)，洛林大学-南锡二大 (Université Nancy 2)，洛林大学-梅兹大学(Université de Metz)，洛林大学-国立洛林综合理工学院。



目前洛林大学拥有8个博士生院，2100多名在校博士生，其中半数为来自于80多个不同国家的外国留学生。每所博士生院在教学和研究方面都有自己的专长，学科领域涉及面广泛，包括生命科学、医学、科学与技术、文学、语言、人文科学、艺术、经济与法学、管理学、环境、物理学、化学、工学、体育运动学等，其中能源与环境科学、医学、材料学、数学与计算机科学以及语言学属于学校重点扶植优势学科。每年洛林大学博士生院承办400余次博士答辩。此外，洛林大学拥有72个受正式资质标签认可的研究实验室，其中大多数与国家大型研究机构(如：法国国家科研中心[CNRS]、

国家健康与医学研究院[INSERM]、国家农学研究院[INRA]、国家计算机与自动装置研究院[INRIA]等)有合作关系。

洛林大学还与亚洲特别是中国建立长期稳定的合作关系。例如梅兹的孔子学院的成立、多年来与武汉大学医学部和中南医院的学术交流和共同培养博士生项目、与武汉理工大学的本科生教育合作项目以及与沈阳东北大学就材料科学领域的合作。

## ATILF Lab Brief Presentation

ATILF (Analyse et Traitement Informatique de la Langue Française – Computer Processing and Analysis of the French Language), a joint research unit of **CNRS** and **Université de Lorraine**, is the result of a merger between the CNRS National Institute for the French Language (Institut National de la Langue Française – INALF) and the Language, Discourse, Cognition (LANDISCO) Laboratory of University Nancy 2 (former name of the Université de Lorraine).

ATILF has already attained worldwide recognition. ATILF is administratively under the **CNRS Humanities and Social Sciences Institute** and also acts as an interface with the Information Sciences and their Interactions Institute.

ATILF is a member of the CNRS - **Institut de Linguistique Française** Federation and of the **TEI** (Text Encoding Initiative) international consortium.
